 We shall be at Riverside City College for an **in-person** event.  
 A limited number of teams (56) will be permitted onsite.

**Alternative Participation Options**

- Teams may participate in a PROCTORED environment, where a coach enforces the rules and certifies the team’s compliance. These teams will be eligible to advance to the North America Championship (NAC). Proctored teams compete using the same environment and rules as teams at RCC.
- Teams that do not have a proctor available will be able to compete online. They will be in a separate division, but will *not* be eligible to advance to the NAC.

All teams must register in the ICPC system in order to compete onsite OR in a proctored setting OR online.



**Fees**

Onsite teams: \$128 Proctored and Online teams: \$ 64



Teams will be invoiced this year. The Invoice will include the payment instructions. (No PayPal.)

**Questionnaire**

Every Team member – coaches included – whether onsite, proctored, or online – must fill out a Questionnaire. A link will be sent to your coach. If you plan to be onsite, you will be asked to provide information about your vaccination status (questions can be skipped if you will not be onsite).

**COVID Constraints for Teams onsite at RCC**

To participate onsite at RCC, you must:

- Be fully vaccinated and boosted; or,
- Be fully vaccinated (no booster) and present a negative COVID-19 test valid within 7 days of the event.

When you arrive on campus, you will present your ID and vaccination record, have your temperature taken, and be given a wristband to wear to show you have been cleared. If you are not vaccinated or cannot present proof of vaccination, you will not be able to compete at RCC.
