ONLINE WARMUP FOR EVERYONE FEB 19

An on-line warm-up/rehearsal for the regional contest will take place on Saturday, February 19. All registered teams are expected to participate. Information about the schedule, accessing & testing the on-line warm-up environment, and asking clarification questions will be in Bulletin 3.

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What is an Eligibility Exception (and how do I get one?)

An eligibility exception is a written request submitted by a Coach to manager@icpc.global, asking ICPC to allow a person to compete who does not exactly fit the criteria for acceptance.

An example of an exception that might be requested is age/start of studies: If you paused or delayed the start of your education for things like military or religious service, or to support a family, an exception is often granted. The goal is to keep the contest fair, and within the spirit of the event.

If you have not don't this before, contact the Registrar (registrar@socalcontest.org) for help if you believe an exception is warranted.

Registration Site

Coaches should register all teams at icpc.global, and choose the "Riverside City College" site. Then use the Team Record -> Contest Specific Fields tab to enter "where" the team(s) want compete: onsite@RCC, at a Proctored Site or online. Teams that will compete online or at Proctored sites will be moved to those sites by the Registrar.

IMPORTANT UPDATE ON T-Shirts!

ICPC HQ has decided that the best way to get t-shirts to teams is for COACHES TO ORDER THEM directly, receive and distribute them. The Registrar will forward ordering information to coaches once teams and team members are eligible for approval. If orders are placed by Feb. 14, ICPC HQ believes coaches will have the shirts before the contest. If the deadline is missed, shirts can be ordered, but may not arrive in time for the contest.

Questionnaire

Every Team member - coaches included - whether onsite, proctored, or online - must fill out a Questionnaire. If you plan to be onsite; you will be asked to provide information about your vaccination status (these questions can be skipped if you will not be onsite). The Registrar will forward



the link after teams are entered.
