CAN I STILL REGISTER A TEAM?

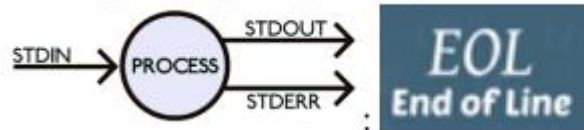
