Be Prepared!

The weather is going to be COLD and WET. Wear appropriate non-skid footwear, and, no running, please! Consider bringing some sort of bag/container for your umbrella or wet jacket – and one to carry your lunch from the truck to the cafeteria. We are setting up extra EZUps to provide a “tunnel” to the snack tent. The cafeteria is open for our use all day
