FOOD (Let's Eat!)

The following items will be provided. See the *Schedule for the Day* (Bulletin #3) for food availability times. There are no food vendors available on campus.

BREAKFAST: Continental: fruit, rolls, juice, coffee. If you need more substantial fare, please arrange it on your own.



LUNCH: Habit Burger. Please complete the

survey at https://forms.gle/yQZMS6uFaEPDYaGY7 to make your lunch selection. If you do not complete the Survey, you will get a lettuce-wrapped veggie burger.



Lunches will be served in 15 minute intervals. Each team will be assigned to a specific 15-minute interval. Lunch will be <u>concurrent</u> with the on-site Shake-Out (AKA Warm-up). Please get your lunch at your assigned time. If you miss your time, you

will need to go after the last scheduled group.

SNACKS: The snack area will open around 2:00 p.m.. Please do not ask for anything before the contest starts.

PIZZA will be available after the contest, starting around 6:30 p.m. All pizzas will be generally available; if you asked for no-cheese pizza, it will be set aside and labeled.

Team Approvals and Team Fees

Team approvals will start mid-week. There is no official limit to the number of teams a school may send; there is a limit to the number of teams that will fit in the labs. Generally, the Registrar will approve up to three qualified teams from each school. The remaining teams will be approved as space permits, during the last week before the contest.

Teams will be approved if and only if they are eligible, or have an eligibility extension approved by ICPC Headquarters.



Teams will be invoiced for team fees (\$140 / team) after the team is approved. If any Institution needs to arrange payment sooner, contact treasurer@socalcontest.org.
