PARK in the Terracina lot (red "P").

BREAKFAST: Continental; fruit, rolls, juice, coffee. If you need more substantial fare, please arrange it. **LUNCH**: If you did not complete the Survey, you will obtain a ticket from the Registrar after you check in, from whatever lunches remain. Lunch tickets may not be exchanged. You will be assigned to a specific time during the Shake-Out to go get your lunch. You may return to the Lab to complete the Shake-Out once you have finished lunch.



SNACKS: The snack area will open AFTER the contest starts – not before. Please do not ask for anything before the contest starts.

PIZZA will be available after the contest, starting around 6:30 p.m. All pizza will be generally available; if you asked for nocheese pizza, it will be set aside and labeled.
