See the Schedule for the Day in Bulletin #3 for food availability times. There are no food vendors available on campus.

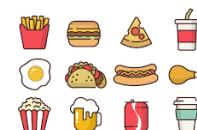
BREAKFAST: Continental; fruit, rolls, juice, coffee. If you need more substantial fare, please arrange it.
